BALLOT TITLE:

CHARTER AMENDMENT TO REQUIRE VOTER APPROVAL OF ANY COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

BALLOT SUMMARY:

The charter amendment requires voter approval of any community redevelopment plan (defined in Florida Statutes Chapter 163) before the community redevelopment plan can be adopted by the Commission.

The undersigned electors of the City of St. Pete Beach hereby request that the following proposed amendment to Article III of the City Charter of St. Pete Beach be submitted to the electors of the City of St. Pete Beach in accordance with Florida Statute Section 166.031 and the City Charter:

FULL TEXT OF PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT:

Section 3.17 Voter Approval Required For Approval of or Effectiveness of Community Redevelopment Plan.

“A community redevelopment plan as defined in Florida Statutes Section 163 shall not be adopted by the City Commission until such proposed community redevelopment plan is approved by a vote of the electors by referendum as provided by Florida Statute Section 166.031 or by the City Charter. This amendment shall become effective immediately upon approval by a majority of the electors voting in such referendum.”
