

**A PETITION FOR A REFERENDUM
TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER OF ST. PETE BEACH**

BALLOT TITLE:

CHARTER AMENDMENT TO REQUIRE VOTER APPROVAL OF ANY INCREASE IN ALLOWABLE HEIGHT OF ANY STRUCTURE

BALLOT SUMMARY:

The charter amendment requires voter approval for any amendment to the city’s Land Development Code which would increase the allowable “height” (as defined by the Land Development Code) of any “structure” (as defined by the Land Development Code).

The undersigned electors of the City of St. Pete Beach hereby request that the following proposed amendment to Article III of the City Charter of St. Pete Beach be submitted to the electors of the City of St. Pete Beach in accordance with Florida Statute Section 166.031 and the City Charter:

FULL TEXT OF PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT:

Section 3.18 Voter Approval Required For Increase in Allowable Height of Structure

“No amendment to the City’s Land Development Code providing for an increase in the allowable height (as defined by the Land Development Code) of any structure (as defined by the Land Development Code) shall be adopted by the City Commission until such amendment is approved by a vote of the electors by referendum as provided by Florida Statute Section 166.031 or by the City Charter. This amendment shall become effective immediately upon approval by a majority of the electors voting in such referendum.”
